Dear Parents

**Re: International Faculty visit to Paris, Friday 11 to Monday 14 October 2019**

I am writing to inform you that the International Faculty is arranging a visit to Paris in October 2019. We will be leaving on Friday 11 October and returning on Monday 14 October. We will be travelling with PGL and using their accommodation on the outskirts of Paris, Château de Grande Romaine, a 19<sup>th</sup> Century château set in 70 acres of land, just 20 miles from Paris. The visit will cost **£400**, which includes travel to and from all destinations, insurance, food from Friday to Monday lunchtime and all entrance fees. Students will need money for snacks, drinks and any souvenirs they might wish to buy.

The itinerary is outlined below:

Friday 11	Travel to Paris – visit to a chocolate factory
Sat 12	Trip to Paris – incl. Bateaux Parisiens boat trip/Montmartre/Eiffel Tower and Evening activity
Sun 13	EuroDisney/Planet Hollywood
Mon 14	Return via visit to a hypermarché

For students of French, this visit will provide your son or daughter with an excellent opportunity to visit the sights of Paris and to practise their use of everyday French. In addition, students will be encouraged to speak as much French as possible during the visit and French lessons will be run on the coach.

In the past, students have said the visit to Paris is one of the best experiences they have had.

If you would like your son or daughter to go on the visit, please pay a non-refundable deposit of **£70** via Parent Pay **by Friday 1<sup>st</sup> February**. The subsequent payments are detailed as follows:

Second payment of £100	by Friday 1 <sup>st</sup> March 2019
Third payment of £130	by Friday 3 May 2019
Fourth payment of £100	by Friday 7 June 2019

In the event that the visit is oversubscribed, names will be picked at random. In light of recent terrorist attacks across Europe, we will be following the guidelines and advice issued by the French and British governments and will assess and review any day visits as necessary to safeguard our students and staff.

Students will need their own passports to travel; these need to be valid for the **entire visit** if not the passport will need to be renewed, which takes a minimum of three weeks.
